

PLANT MANAGER

Blue Planet is seeking a Plant Manager. The position will be located at our San Francisco Bay Aggregates (SFBA) facility in Pittsburg, California and will report to the VP of Engineering.

Responsibilities and Duties

- The Plant Manager will oversee day-to-day operations at the SFBA site, ensuring that all activities are done safely, in compliance with company policy, and according to approved work orders.
- The Plant Manager will be a “hands-on” team player who will operate the process, oversee modifications to the facility, and maintain equipment as baseline activities.
- The Plant Manager will lead a small team of Operations Engineers and Operators that will assist the Plant Manager in developing procedures and operating the SFBA pilot facilities accordingly.
- The Plant Manager will interface with applicable regulatory agencies to ensure that all activities comply with all applicable codes and laws.
- The Plant Manager will be responsible for critical site activities including scheduling, participation in design and safety reviews, and infrastructure development.
- The Plant Manager will be responsible for regular communications with Blue Planet leadership.

Qualifications

- A minimum of 5 years of experience in plant operations including at least three years in a leadership role (plant manager or similar supervisory role) is required.
- A high school diploma is required. A college degree or equivalent relevant training, such as military training or operations-specific training, is highly desirable.
- Good communication skills, an optimistic outlook, and the ability to manage in an environment of shifting needs are critical.
- The ability to perform physical labor is required. Basic maintenance skills, such as welding, basic motor repair, or small scale electrical, are highly desirable.
